Natural Resources and Economy of Southern Africa

ACTIVITY 1:

Ask your teacher for a blank map of Africa and the economic picture symbols from the **Blackline Master File (BLM)**.

1) Using **Industry Organizer for Southern Africa** as a resource, paste the **major** product symbols to the countries in Southern Africa that we have studied. **Remember**, countries of Southern Africa have products in common, so picture symbols may be used more than once.

2) Draw a symbol if one is not included in your **BLM**.

3) In parenthesis, behind each symbol on your map, write **1** to represent a primary industry, **2** to represent a secondary industry, and **3** to represent a tertiary industry.

ACTIVITY 2:

Use an **Industry Bullseye** from your **Blackline Master File (BLM)** to list the economic activities of the country of South Africa. Refer to the Industry Organizer in Activity 1, or you may research the economy of South Africa on the Internet or in your school library.
